Overview Cogeneration System Improvements



- Existing cogeneration system is critical element of District's efforts to generate onsite renewable energy via biogas use
 - 0.8-MW cogeneration system meets ~50-55% of WWTP power needs
- Board awarded detailed design contract in February 2023 to replace existing aging infrastructure
- Staff implemented accelerated project schedule to qualify for federal tax credits under Inflation Reduction Act
 - ~\$6.5M in tax credits requires project to be in construction by December 2024
 - Issue construction bid documents (June 2024), award construction contract (August 2024)
- Significant increase in project cost



Cogeneration System Improvements Project Cost Increase



- Significant increase in project cost as design progressed
 - \$20.0M⁺ at 95% design completion status
 - Staff has increased project cost in proposed 5-year CIP from \$7.0M to \$13.5M (assuming \$6.5M in federal tax credits)
- Staff is revisiting economic analyses to confirm "go/no go" decision following receipt of construction bids in June 2024
 - Current construction cost estimate = \$16.4M
 - Project does not appear to be economically viable without tax credits
 - Considering non-economic factors (energy independence, resiliency)

Consultant Services Contract Construction Management Services



- District requires construction management services in advance of construction contract award
 - Conduct constructability and biddability reviews, ensure compliance with federal Inflation Reduction Act requirements
- District issued request for proposals in February 2024
 - Two consulting firms submitted proposals
 - Psomas selected as most highly-qualified firm
- Staff has negotiated scope of services and cost (\$1.6M)
 - Biddability and Constructability Review (\$75k)
 - Construction Management (\$847k)
 - Construction Inspection and Specialty Inspection (\$542k)
 - Bid Services Support (\$91k)
 - Project Closeout (\$40k)
